During the past year, E&O claims involving certificates of insurance have increased 28%. Almost 1 in 20 E&O claims now involves a certificate of insurance. The two main sources of certificate E&O claims are failure to add, or improperly identifying, additional insureds (36%) and misrepresenting coverage on the certificate that doesn't actually exist (21%). Do your producers and CSRs truly understand the important coverage and E&O issues involved in issuing certificates?
